



SmartLoad® user guide

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This document gives an introduction to the use of the SmartLoad[®] handset. Section 2.3 is the procedure to power up the handset and add load cells. Procedures 2.4 to 2.10 are introductions to each of the features of the handset and may be referred to as and when required. For full operating information refer to the relevant SmartLoad[®] operating manual (e.g. document reference 376451).

Note – this shows the battery cover for a tension link. The packaging will differ slightly in other applications, e.g. shackles, but all new devices will have a similar battery box with a tape that must be removed to connect the batteries.
